- In 1962, the company diversified, adding ERW steel pipe to its product line. Today, AMERICAN Steel Pipe makes API line pipe in diameters from 12 ¾ inches to 24 inches, in lengths up to 80 feet.

At AMERICAN, we do it safely or not at all.

Welcome to AMERICAN. We're glad to have you as our guest. To ensure your safety and the safety of those around you, we ask that you observe the following safety guidelines while onsite.



Parking and Building Access

- Please display your parking pass on the dash of your vehicle and wear your visitor's badge where it can be easily seen.
- Park only in authorized areas and use designated entrances and exits to the plant. Roll up doors are for vehicles only.
- Use of video equipment, cameras or cell phone photography is strictly prohibited unless authorized in advance.
- Smoking is permitted only in designated smoking areas outside buildings.
- Firearms and other weapons are strictly prohibited in all work areas of campus.
- Upon entering a building, please sign in and wait in the lobby. The employee you're visiting will meet you in the lobby.



What to Wear

- Long pants and casual shirt or t-shirt should be worn. Also, flat sturdy, closed-toe, closed-heel shoes must be worn in the manufacturing areas of the plant.
- Other Personal Protective Equipment – a hard hat, ear plugs and safety glasses – will be provided by AMERICAN and is required to be worn in all manufacturing areas of the plant.



Traffic – Stop, Look and Listen

- Obey all posted speed limit and traffic signs. Yield right of way to fork lifts and other heavy equipment and give them wide clearance, mindful that operators may have a restricted view and be unable to see vehicles and pedestrians.



While Touring the Plant

- Use doors to enter and exit buildings and stay on designated walk ways.
- Use handrails and do not touch equipment or manufactured products, which may be extremely hot and/or sharp.
- Be mindful of slip, trip and fall hazards; and moving overhead equipment such as cranes and hoists.

Emergency Procedures



Tornado/Shelter

- In the event of bad weather, Plant Protection will monitor conditions and sound campus tornado sirens if employees and guests should take shelter. AMERICAN's public address system will also provide audible warnings. Your escort will guide you to the nearest shelter. Please remain sheltered until Plant Protection sounds the all clear. (This is a low-pitch sound that is distinctively different from the high-pitch warning sound.)



Fire/Evacuation

- In the event the building you are in is evacuated, follow your escort or a posted evacuation map to the designated assembly point outside. Wait here. Plant Protection will ensure everyone is accounted for and will signal when it is clear to re-enter the building.
